Legend: Candidates in **green** are eligible for the BIP and its scholarship. Candidates in **yellow** may become eligible in the case that previous candidates eligible do not confirm, or later cancel their former acceptance. The order of replacement is the one showed by the rank; in the case of score parity, further priority criteria apply.

REMIND: A few basic rules (see also BIP tender).

- 1) No communication regarding the outcome of the selection will be sent to the eligible candidates.
- 2) The eligible students are required to confirm the scholarship **by Wednesday 29 January 2025** (at the latest!) by sending an email to n.matteucci@univpm.it, otherwise the application will be cancelled and the person next in the ranking will be contacted by sending an email to his/her institutional email address. Of course, better to confirm it as soon as you can, to help our organization and planning.

3) In your own interest, please ask a reading confirmation to the professor, for your e-mail.

- 4) Please, before confirming the scholarship, verify carefully that you can attend to the BIP. Eg., if you have a job or an internship ongoing, check with the relevant employer that you have the permit to be abroad in the week 2-8 March (the BIP programme will run from 3 to 7 of March, but you need to arrive on Sunday 2 and leave on Saturday 8). In fact, the student who has confirmed participation in the BIP may withdraw only for exceptional reasons (so called reasons of “force majeure”), to be motivated by email to n.matteucci@univpm.it, together with the relevant documentation.

At the beginning of the next week, Prof. Matteucci will send travel tips and infos on arrangements and local accommodation. Remember that the organization of your travel and accommodation to Bucharest is your responsibility.
